

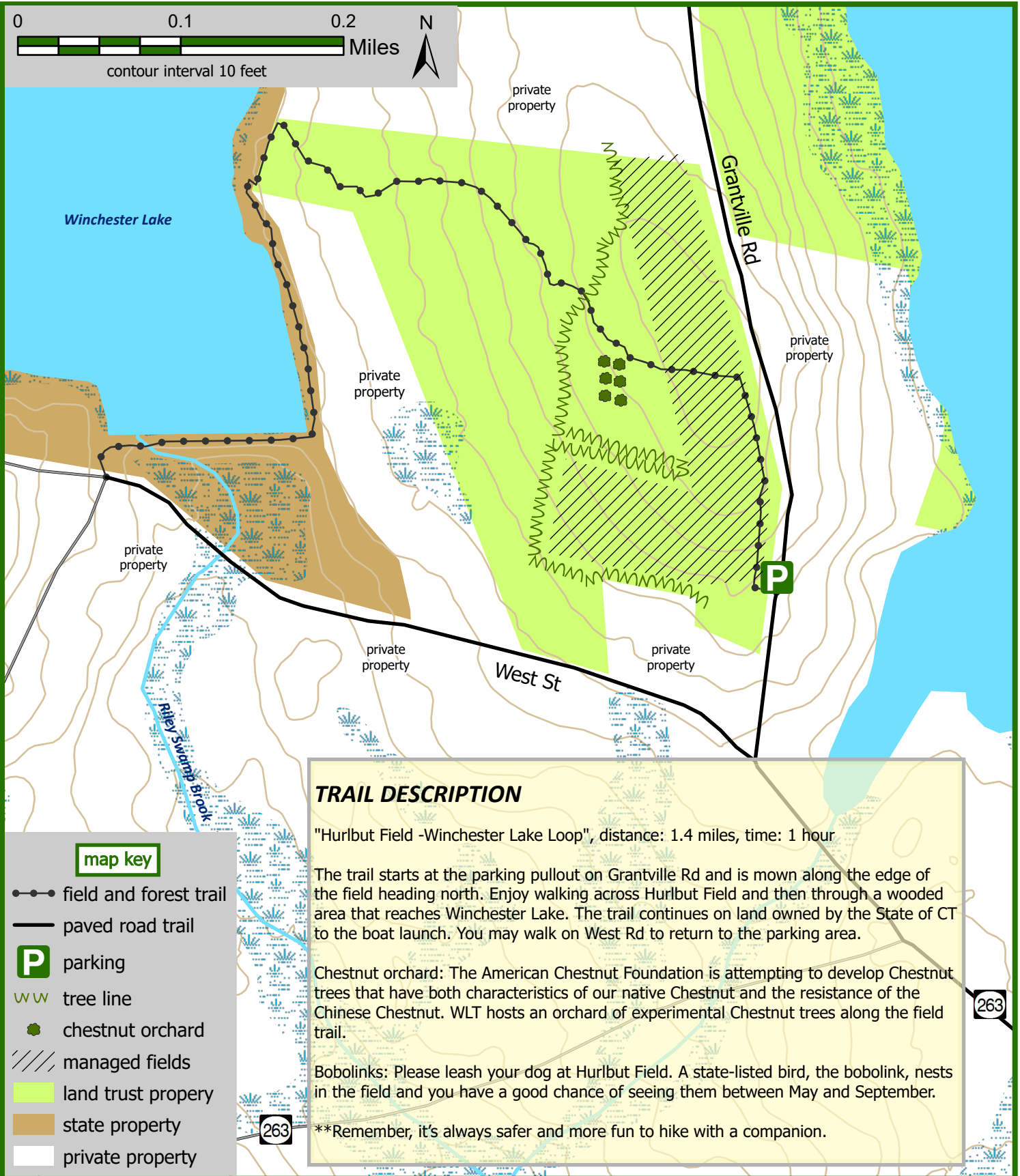

TRAIL DESCRIPTION

"Hurlbut Field -Winchester Lake Loop", distance: 1.4 miles, time: 1 hour

The trail starts at the parking pullout on Grantville Rd and is mown along the edge of the field heading north. Enjoy walking across Hurlbut Field and then through a wooded area that reaches Winchester Lake. The trail continues on land owned by the State of CT to the boat launch. You may walk on West Rd to return to the parking area.

Chestnut orchard: The American Chestnut Foundation is attempting to develop Chestnut trees that have both characteristics of our native Chestnut and the resistance of the Chinese Chestnut. WLT hosts an orchard of experimental Chestnut trees along the field trail.

Bobolinks: Please leash your dog at Hurlbut Field. A state-listed bird, the bobolink, nests in the field and you have a good chance of seeing them between May and September.
