

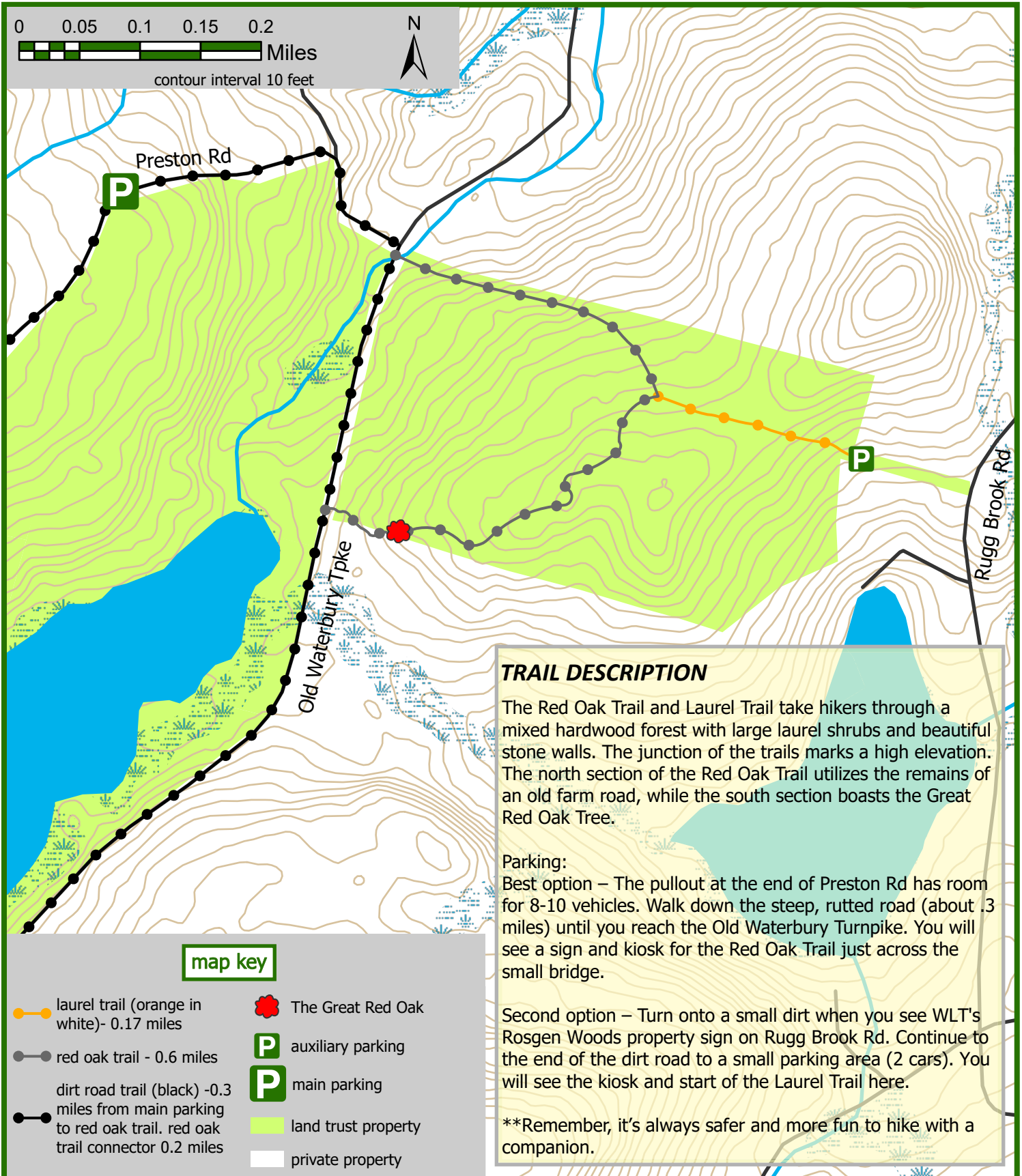

TRAIL DESCRIPTION

The Red Oak Trail and Laurel Trail take hikers through a mixed hardwood forest with large laurel shrubs and beautiful stone walls. The junction of the trails marks a high elevation. The north section of the Red Oak Trail utilizes the remains of an old farm road, while the south section boasts the Great Red Oak Tree.

Parking:
 Best option – The pullout at the end of Preston Rd has room for 8-10 vehicles. Walk down the steep, rutted road (about .3 miles) until you reach the Old Waterbury Turnpike. You will see a sign and kiosk for the Red Oak Trail just across the small bridge.

Second option – Turn onto a small dirt when you see WLT's Rosgen Woods property sign on Rugg Brook Rd. Continue to the end of the dirt road to a small parking area (2 cars). You will see the kiosk and start of the Laurel Trail here.

****Remember, it's always safer and more fun to hike with a companion.**
